# **Management Discussion**

### FY 2019-20 Operating Budget Highlights

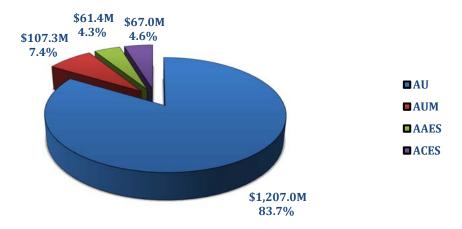


Figure 1: Auburn University Budget by Division for the Auburn University System

The proposed budget for FY 2019-20 is \$1.443 billion and is divided into the four budgetary divisions as illustrated in **Figure 1**. This budget has increased by \$94 million, or 6.94%, from the approved FY 2018-19 budget.

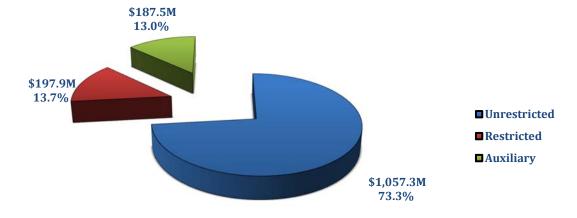


Figure 2: Auburn University Budget by Funding Category for the Auburn University System

The budget is grouped into three fund types for revenue and expenses based on certain characteristics of the sources and uses of the funds: unrestricted, restricted, and auxiliary. As shown in **Figure 2**, the majority of the University's funding falls into the unrestricted category.

### Revenues

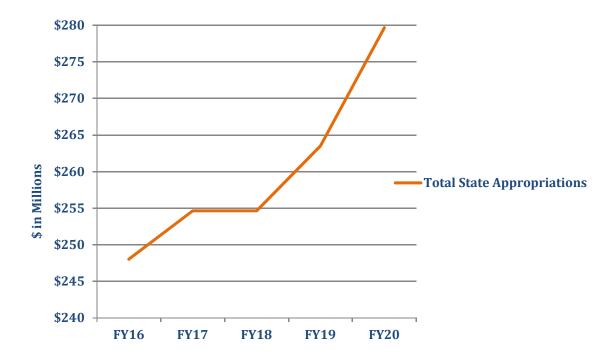
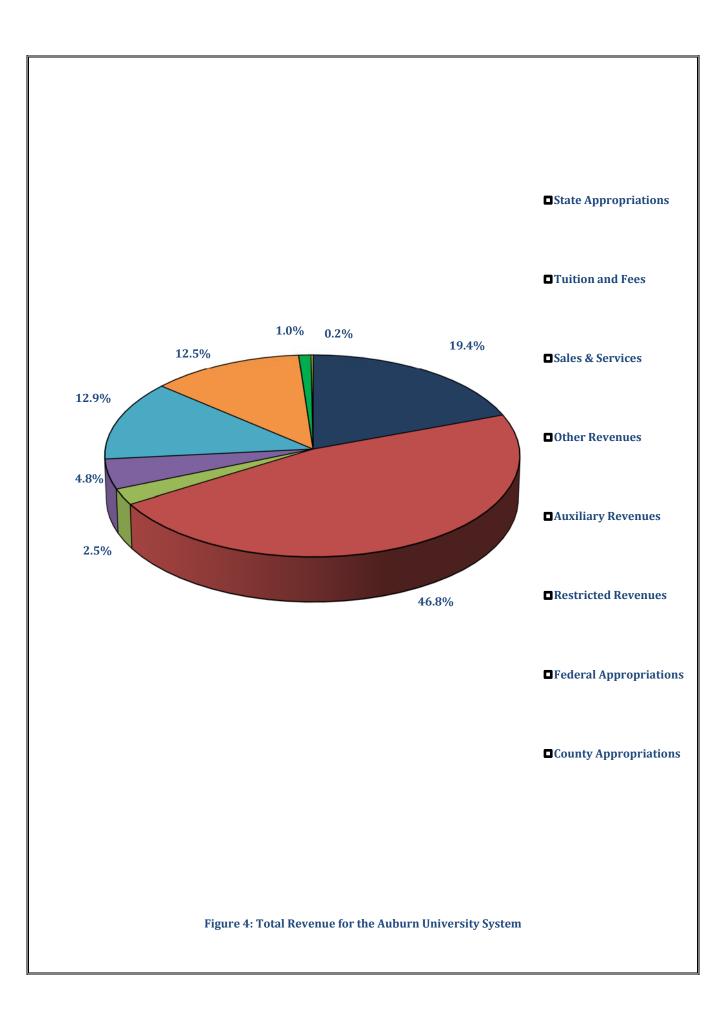


Figure 3: 5-Year Trend for State Appropriations for the Auburn University System

State appropriations revenue increased by \$16.1M (6.1%) for FY 2019-20. The trend for growth in state appropriations since FY 2015-16 has been positive as exhibited in **Figure 3**, despite receiving level appropriations in FY 2017-18.

Tuition and fees revenue increased by \$31.5 million due to recent positive enrollment trends coupled with an increase in tuition rates (2% at Auburn-Main Campus and 3% at AUM). A change in budget philosophy resulted in an additional \$35M being included in the budget. There were also increases in *restricted* revenues of \$16.0 million, and *other* revenue of \$6.4 million. *Auxiliary* revenues decreased by \$11.5 million.

The University has numerous revenue sources as seen in **Figure 4**. State appropriations and tuition & fees make up almost 66% of the total proposed budget for FY 2019-20, which is slightly higher than the 65% they represented in FY 2018-19.



### **Expenses**

The largest increases in expenses for the FY 2019-20 budget are related to salary enhancements and hiring initiatives, an increase of \$40 million across all divisions. Like the prior year's budget, a merit cap was calculated for each of the units based on certain criteria, which results in an average merit-based permanent salary increase of 3.5% for all divisions of Auburn University. With the exception of AUM, the proposed budget also includes provisions for a one-time salary supplement, which is consistent with recent years. The pool for the one-time supplement was capped at \$1,500 per eligible employee. In addition to the permanent merit adjustments, each division funded promotions for its faculty and staff, accounting for additional growth in the budget from the prior year. Other growth is due to hiring initiatives in the academic areas because of enrollment shifts and efforts to continually enhance Auburn's research profile.

Other planned increases are for student aid and waivers, mandatory cost increases under University contracts, or operational needs for new buildings. Student aid and waivers increased by \$7.9 million from the prior year. The mandatory cost increases are for the contract with the City of Auburn for police and fire services, inflationary cost increases on computer software, and insurance premiums. In addition to the Gogue Preforming Arts Center, several other buildings will be coming online during FY 2019-20. The impact of the mandatory costs and new buildings results in an increase of \$3.7 million in the budget. Other operating expenses across all divisions increased by an additional \$10M due to inflation and estimated growth in restricted expenses. Resources of \$5 million have been set aside to fund initiatives related to research and \$27.5M is being set aside for contingencies.

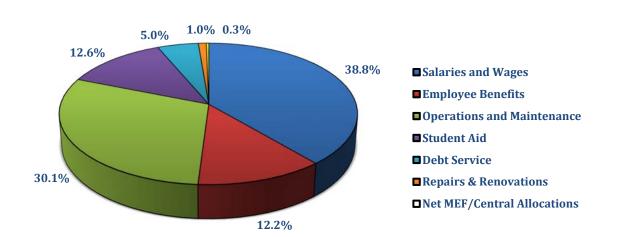
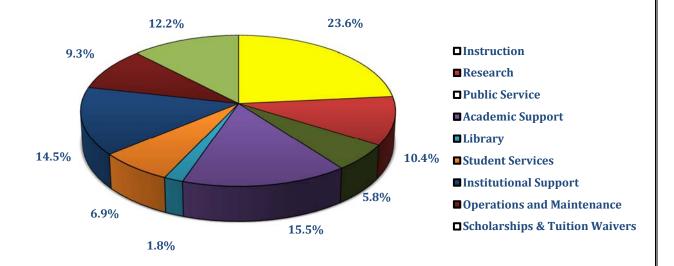


Figure 5: Expenses by Object for the Auburn University System

The University presents its expense budget in two major ways: by object and by function. There are four major categories used to identify expenses by object: Salaries and Wages, Employee Benefits, Operations and Maintenance, and Student Aid. The Operations and Maintenance category can also be broken into additional categories for: Debt Service, Repairs and Renovation, and Net Mission Enhancement Funding. The breakdown of expenses by object is illustrated with **Figure 5** on the following page.

The University also budgets and records its expenses by function. The functional categories are meant to identify the purpose for the expense. **Figure 6**, on the following page, gives the breakdown by function for the University. The functional expense breakdown only includes unrestricted funds as restricted and auxiliary funds have multiple functional classifications that are not readily assignable to one of the categories.

### **Strategic Budgeting Initiative (SBI)**

This proposed budget marks the fourth year of budget development under the SBI. The same principles for revenue and indirect expense allocation apply, although the variable percentages changed to be reflective of the most recent full year of data (for academic and fiscal year 2017-18). The specific data points and percentages are on the tables in the Allocation Metrics section.

During the budget development cycle for FY 2019-20, the governance committees again participated in building the proposed budget. The University Budget Advisory Committee continues to provide oversight for the budgeting process. ### **Mission Enhancement Fund (MEF)**

The MEF participation rate continues to be 17.5% assessed on all allocated revenues and certain direct revenues. The funds generated are used for both subvention and strategic investment. For FY 2019-20, the amount generated in the MEF before reallocation is \$116.2 million. Subvention needs are approximately \$110.3 million, which yields a strategic investment portion of \$5.9 million.
