Management Discussion

FY 2021-22 Operating Budget Highlights

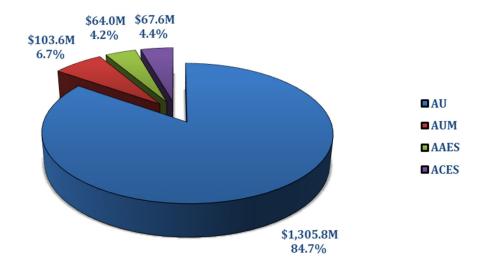


Figure 1: Auburn University Budget by Division for the Auburn University System

The proposed budget for FY 2021-22 is \$1.541 billion and is divided into the four budgetary divisions as illustrated in **Figure 1**. This budget has increased by \$56.9 million, or 3.84%, from the approved FY 2020-21 budget.

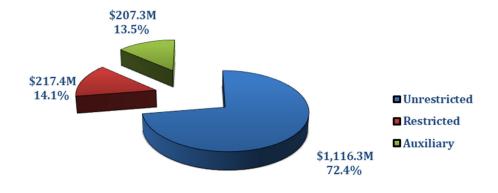


Figure 2: Auburn University Budget by Funding Category for the Auburn University System

The budget is grouped into three fund types for revenue and expenses based on certain characteristics of the sources and uses of the funds: unrestricted, restricted, and auxiliary. As shown in **Figure 2**, the majority of the University's funding falls into the unrestricted category.

Revenues

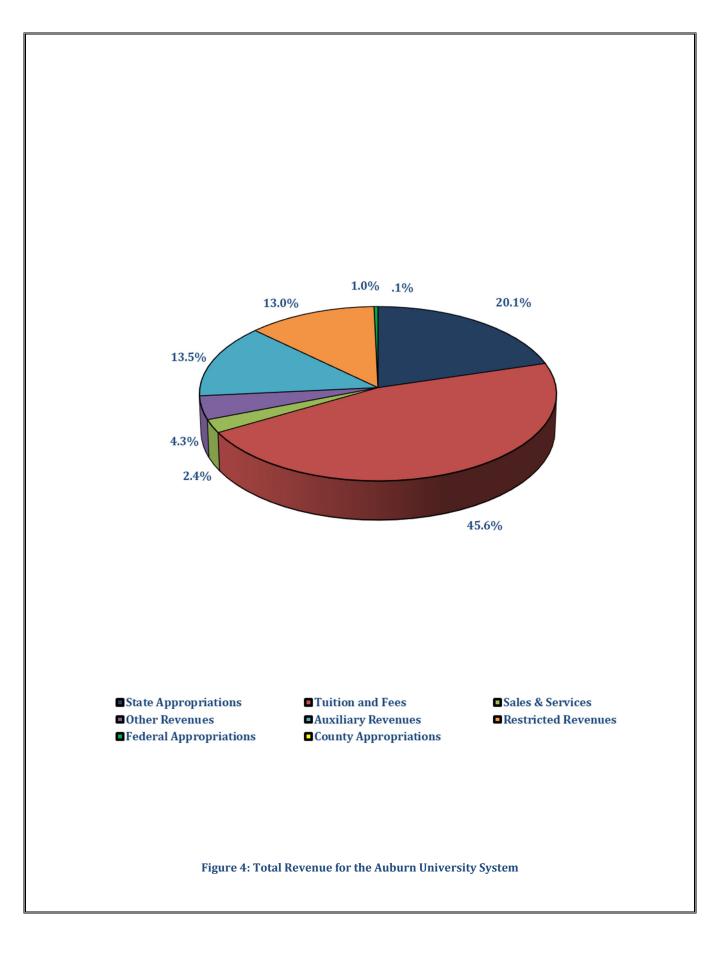
State appropriations revenue increased by \$19.9M (6.9%) for FY 2021-22. The trend for growth in state appropriations since FY 2018 has been positive as exhibited in **Figure 3**. State revenue collections are consistently strong and point to a continued increase in appropriations in the near term.

Tuition rates for Auburn-Main Campus and AUM were held constant for the FY 2021-22 academic year. *Tuition and fees* revenue did increase by \$13.3M (1.9%) due to recent positive enrollment trends. The main campus is anticipating it's largest freshman class ever. There were also increases in *restricted* revenues of \$14.1M (6.9%) and auxiliary revenues increased by \$14.0M (7.3%). Other revenues decreased by \$4.5M (4.0%).

The University has numerous revenue sources as seen in **Figure 4.** State appropriations and tuition & fees make up almost 66% of the total proposed budget for FY 2021-22, which is equal to the 66% they represented in FY 2020-21.



Expenses

The largest increase in expenses for the proposed budget is in salaries and wages. The university is planning for a 3% merit increase which accounts for \$13.2 million of an overall \$35.9 million increase. The other increases are for job family and faculty promotions (\$1.4 million), new faculty and administrative positions (\$6.8 million), the conversion of contracted employees at the Harris Early Learning Center (\$1.5 million), job realignments (\$2.7 million), on-going contractual payments to former employees (\$7.3 million) and continued budget refinement of multi-filled positions to match historic spending trends (\$3 million). Employee benefits increased by \$7.4 million from the prior year mainly due to the increases in salaries and wages but also due to a slight increase in the full-time fringe benefit rate from 30.4% to 31.0%.

The largest non-personnel increase is in debt service of \$16.7M. The majority of this increase pertains to a 2020 bond issuance that occurred later in the summer right as this budget document was completed. Funds were reallocated from other areas of the budget (mainly operating expenses) to provide resources to cover these mandatory cost increases. There was an issuance of new debt in 2021 for the purchase of transit buses that also contributes to the increase. Other areas of growth include student aid of \$5.5 million, which includes additional funding for need-based scholarships, and a net decrease in operations and maintenance costs of \$1.3 million even though there were increases related to contractual obligations for software, increases in insurance premiums, and occupancy costs on new buildings.

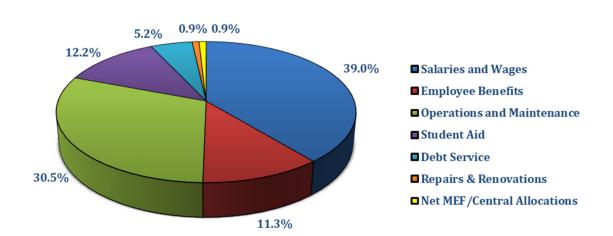


Figure 5: Expenses by Object for the Auburn University System

The University presents its expense budget in two major ways: by object and by function. There are four major categories used to identify expenses by object: Salaries and Wages, Employee Benefits, Operations and Maintenance, and Student Aid. The Operations and Maintenance category can also be broken into additional categories for: Debt Service, Repairs and Renovation, and Net Mission Enhancement Funding. The breakdown of expenses by object is illustrated with **Figure 5** on the following page.

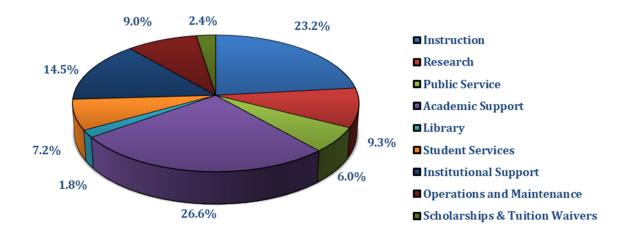


Figure 6: Expenses by Function for the Auburn University System

The University also budgets and records its expenses by function. The functional categories are meant to identify the purpose for the expense. **Figure 6**, on the following page, gives the breakdown by function for the University. The functional expense breakdown only includes unrestricted funds as restricted and auxiliary funds have multiple functional classifications that are not readily assignable to one of the categories.

Strategic Budgeting Initiative (SBI)

The proposed budget continues the legacy of the strategic budgeting initiative which allows for a more data-driven resource allocation process. The budget includes some slight changes in percentage allocations from the first five years of the model. Previously, all undergraduate tuition was distributed to the colleges based on a 70%/30% split between college of instruction and college of record/major. That split was changed to be 65%/35% in the current iteration of the model. In addition, the graduate tuition allocation was changed from 100% being directed to the college of record to a 90%/10% split between the college of record and college of instruction. The last change in allocation percentages was to replace a 70%/30% split of state appropriations between resident tuition allocated and sponsored activity to a 65%/35% split. The variables used for allocation continue to be based on the last full year of data, meaning there is a one year lag for most model variables. The specific data points and percentages are on the tables in the Allocation Metrics section.

During the budget development cycle for FY 2021-22, the governance committees played a part in building the proposed budget. The University Budget Advisory Committee continues to provide oversight for the budgeting process. Additionally, the committee serves in an advisory role to senior administration on high-level budgetary matters, some of which includes recommendation of changes to allocation methods. Mission Enhancement Fund (MEF)

The MEF participation rate increased to be 20% and is now only assessed on allocated revenues. The funds generated are used for both subvention and strategic investment. For FY 2021-22, the amount generated in the MEF before reallocation is \$122 million. Subvention needs are approximately \$108.3 million, which yields a strategic investment portion of \$13.7 million.

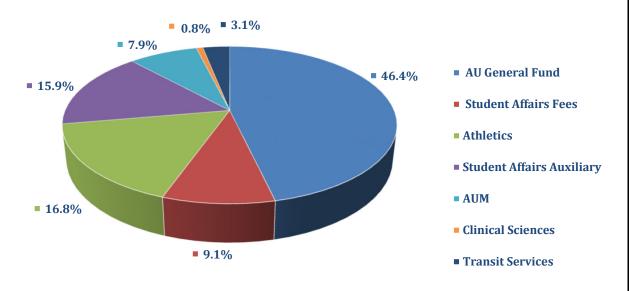

Auburn University Central Allocation Metrics Student Headcount













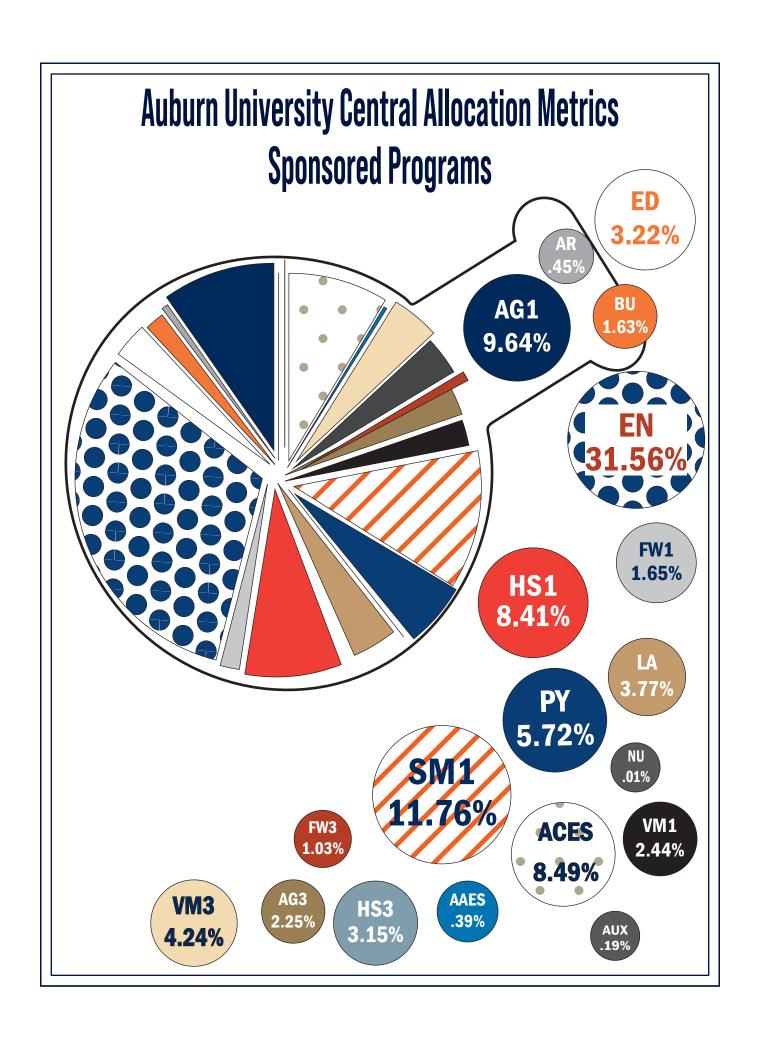
